ROCK Updates

- Imaging Classification Committee: The imaging committee has completed the MRI classification system. Next steps to include: 1. Final Review by Image Classification Group 2. Dissemination to all members for review. 3. ROCK Group Review at annual meeting, Jan 2016
- Research Funding.
 - a. Allosource. Committed 50K/year for 3 years for unrestricted educational
 - b. BREG Positive response from the Clinical Review Committee, will make final decision and inform ROCK by Oct 26, 2015
 - c. OSSUR considering support for Prospective Cohort to study to look at outcomes for unloader braces for OCD treatment
 - d. MRI Imaging Reliability Study. Radiologic Society of North American -Grant application may be submitted Jan, 2016, to fund MRI Classification study. Special Thanks to Jutta Ellerman, Greg Myer, Peter Cannamela, for work on this project
- 3. Image Storage. Cincinnati Childrens is working to develop a portal, both for reliability research, and for de-identified image storage. Expect more details by Jan, 2016. This may allow us to complete the MRI reliability study at lower cost and offer excellent storage and review for the images from the prospective cohort.
